

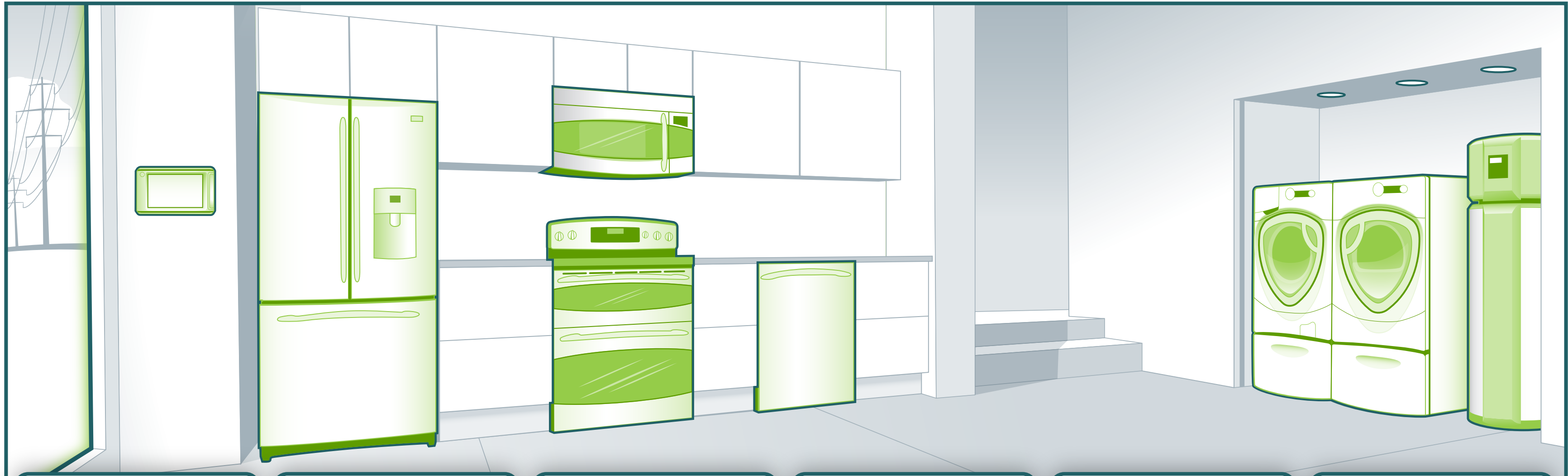
GE Energy Management & Demand Response Appliances
